

To start, Stonhard flooring experts examined LATTC's concrete slab. First, Stonfil OP2, a resin floor primer, was applied to mitigate any potential moisture. Next, since leveling and crack issues needed to be addressed, Stonhard installers applied Stonproof ME7, a liquid-applied, urethane waterproofing membrane that also works as a crack-bridging isolation layer. These preparation

procedures ensure the flooring system will look and perform as expected for many years to come.

The recommended flooring for LATTC's busy commercial and culinary training kitchen was Stonclad UT, a troweled, polyurethane, textured mortar system, that stands up to spills, organic acids, aggressive cleaning, and chemicals. 
